Outreach clinics are also run in Winanga-Li and Gunida Gunyah. For further information or to book an appointment contact Clinic 468 Tamworth.

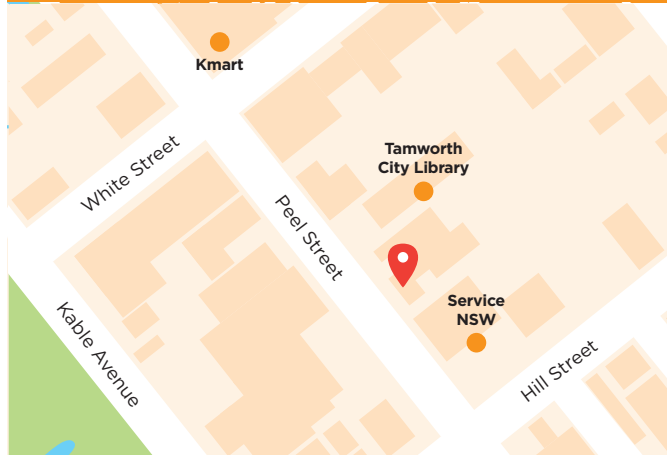

## SERVICES WE PROVIDE

All services we provide are free and confidential.

- Testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections (STIs), HIV and Hepatitis B & C
- HIV rapid testing (at some sites, call to find out where)
- Information and advice on sexual health and STIs
- HIV treatment, care and support
- Counselling on sexual health and HIV related issues
- Hepatitis A and B vaccination provided free to those most at risk
- Free condoms and lubricant
- Pre and Post Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP and PEP) for people at high risk of contracting HIV
- Ongoing support & treatment if you have a positive result
- Friendly and non-judgmental staff
- Interpreter available – please advise when making appointment if required

If you would prefer a male or female clinician, please advise when making your appointment.

**Remember:** using a condom every time you have sex will help keep you safe from most STIs.



## ABOUT CLINIC 468

Located in the heart of town, Clinic 468 offers a variety of sexual health and HIV services and support programs. It is easy to access from public transport routes and free parking is available on Peel Street.

Clinic 468 is a specialised service for people most at risk of STIs & HIV. This includes:

- People with symptoms
- Men who have sex with men
- Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander people
- People who may have travelled or have been in contact with others from high risk countries
- People who work in the sex industry
- People who inject drugs

Most services we offer are also available through your local GP.

Consultations at Clinic 468 are bulk billed with your consent and no gap payment for your consultation is required. You will still be seen even if you don't have a Medicare card.

### STI and HIV Testing

Routine screening may include:

- Chlamydia
- Gonorrhoea
- Syphilis
- HIV
- Hepatitis B
- Hepatitis C
